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UPDATE: Crews Now Installing Storm Drainage Pipeline in Addition to Blasting

Crews have begun installing storm drainage pipeline on the west end of Paseo Del Norte, working east. While this activity does not impact additional travel lanes, there will be increased truck traffic in the area.

Also, **rock blasting is continuing**. While blasting normally occurs in the afternoon, it can take place any time during the day. Typically, when blasting occurs the intersection of **Unser Blvd. and Paseo Del Norte is COMPLETELY CLOSED** for about **30 minutes to one hour** for safety. Blasting is expected to occur **occasionally for the rest of the 2026 from Monday-Saturday as needed**. **Motorists are encourage to seek an alternate route.**

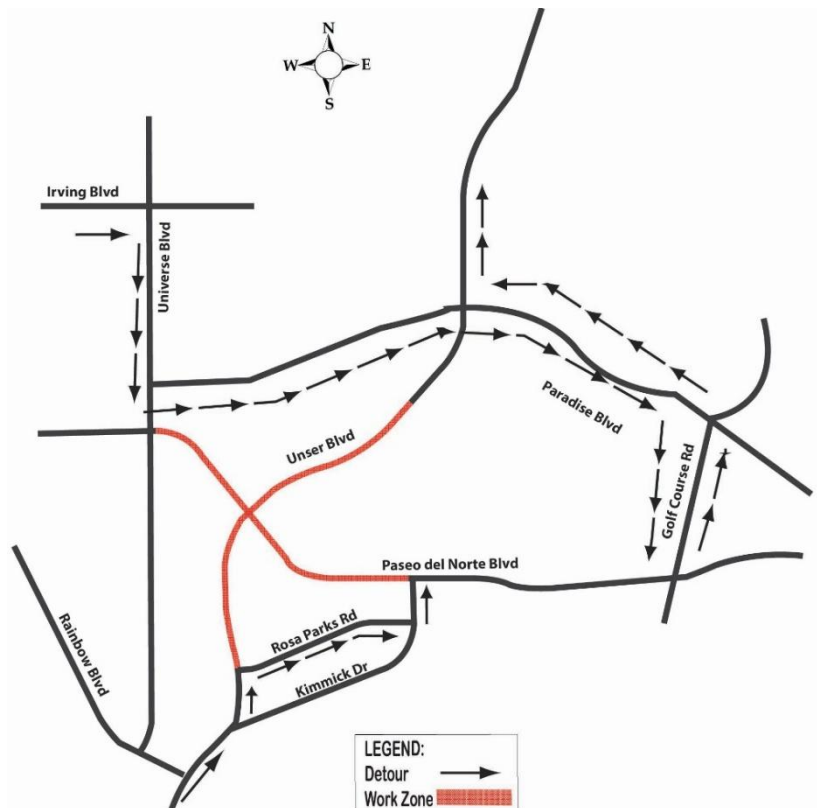
Detour:

- From the **north** take **Universe Blvd to Paradise Blvd to Golf Course Rd** to access Paseo Del Norte
- From the **east**, take **Golf Course to Paradise Road** to access Unser
- From the **west** take **Rainbow to Kimmick to Rosa Parks** to access Paseo del Norte

The best course of action if you need a reach a destination at a specific time is to follow the detours. We apologize the inconvenience and appreciate your patience as we work to get the blasting completed.

Ongoing Traffic Impacts

Unser Blvd - Traffic is open in its existing alignment on southbound Unser. Northbound Unser has a left lane, thru lane and thru/right lane open. At the intersection of Unser Blvd and Paradise Blvd, there is one left lane in addition to a thru/right lane



Paseo del Norte - Eastbound Paseo del Norte is reduced to one lane from west of Golf Course Road. The reduction of westbound Paseo del Norte to one lane has been moved further east, just past the pedestrian bridge. The bike lane is closed at the northwest corner of the intersection of Golf Course Road and Paseo del Norte
